
#### **CWEE** participants' most common barriers to success in FY17:

#### **Age of Partcipants:**



#### **Ethnicity of Partcipants:**




Participants attend CWEE's program 30 hours a week for an average of three to six months, where they learn the skills they need to find, obtain and maintain long-term employment.
