CAREER READINESS – \$25,000

Comprehensive skills training, personal development, family support, employment preparation, and post-employment retention support for 5 career seekers.

STEPS TO SUCCESS – \$20,000

Long-term employment for 30 career seekers by supporting CWEE to engage newly employed participants – and their employers – for a full year to ensure a successful placement.

BRIDGE THE DIGITAL DIVIDE – \$15,000

Technology is the foundation of opportunity, and access to the internet and computers is essential. Provide 50 career seekers with computers to keep plus six months of at-home internet service.

WHEELS TO WORK – \$10,000

Secure reliable transportation for 5 employed alumni, including a safe vehicle, insurance, car seats for children, and an account for maintenance costs.

EVENT SPONSORSHIPS – \$5,000

Create a sense of community and help 200+ career seekers build professional skills, while connecting CWEE's career seekers with local employers. Opportunities include networking fairs, workshops and mentoring events.

BASIC ESSENTIALS SPONSORSHIPS – \$1,000

Support basic needs for 20 families. CWEE provides essential supplies to our career seekers and their families, ensuring access to food, hygiene supplies, diapers and infant formula.
